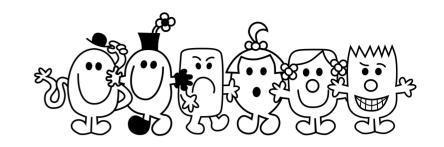




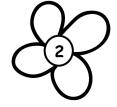

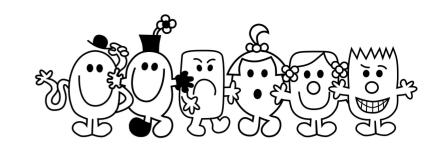

#### INTRODUCTION

The primary purpose of the teacher's pack is to help both teachers and students alike to get as much as possible out of their participation in the interactive performance of "MY LITTLE LIBRARY".

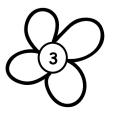
The pack has been designed as a tool to help students understand the play, learn new vocabulary and improve their listening and speaking skills. Once they have done the activities, students will understand better both how the story develops and the lines the actors deliver so they will get more enjoyment out of the performance. The audio material contains some introductory elements where you'll find texts corresponding to the plot synopsis and the characters, some dialogues from the play and the original songs performed in the play. Also, you'll find some suggested activities we recommend you to do before the play, pre-play activities and some post-play activities which have been designed to check if students have understood the play correctly. The activities also enable the student's vocabulary, expressions and grammatical structures to improve.

Pre-play and post-play activities include instructions for the teacher and the corresponding student worksheets, as long as the activity requires them. Some of the activities have an extension part (extension activity) which makes it possible to study the contents in depth, depending on the group's ability. Both the introductory material and the suggested activities may require the corresponding audio material to make better use of them.

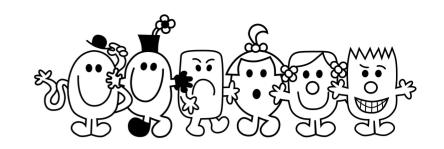

#### CONCEPTUAL CONTENTS

The educational interest of this activity will focus on helping students start developing the basic skills of this foreign language. All this, with an approach based on communication, which aims to encourage students, involving them in dialogues, songs... and other forms of communication that are essential to teaching and learning in the language process.

At this stage students should develop a level of understanding and speaking to enable them to employ their first English communicative manifestations, and ensure their awareness and approach to the Anglo-Saxon cultural tradition.

The teaching materials of "MY LITTLE LIBRARY" will allow you to study in depth the following conceptual contents:

- Present simple tense: third person singular.
- There is/ There are. Affirmative, negative and interrogative sentences.
- How many...?
- Parts of the body and verbs related to them (run, see, jump, dance...)
- Prepositions of place (on, in, under, next to...)
- Physical descriptions. Adjectives.
- Vocabulary related to emotions, feelings and moods.
- Educational values such as friendship, solidarity, collective effort, self-esteem.
- Identification of basic emotions: joy, sadness, anger, fear, calm..., to achieve emotional self-control.
- Deepening of the tools that allow a better self-knowledge, greater self-esteem and an increase of social abilities.

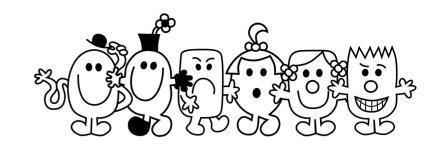
Los intereses educativos de esta actividad se centran en contribuir a que los alumnos se inicien en las destrezas básicas de la lengua extranjera. Todo ello, con un enfoque basado en la comunicación que pretende estimular a los alumnos haciéndoles participar en diálogos, canciones... y otras manifestaciones comunicativas fundamentales en el proceso de enseñanza-aprendizaje de la lengua.

En esta etapa los alumnos deben desarrollar un nivel de comprensión y expresión oral que les permita desplegar sus primeras manifestaciones comunicativas en inglés, además de procurar su sensibilización y acercamiento a la tradición cultural anglosajona.

El material didáctico de "MY LITTLE LIBRARY" os permitirá, además, profundizar en los siguientes contenidos conceptuales:

- Presente simple: tercera persona del singular.
- There is/ There are. Frases afirmativas, negativas e interrogativas.
- How many...?
- Partes del cuerpo y verbos relacionados con ellas (correr, ver, saltar, bailar...)
- Preposiciones de lugar (sobre, en, debajo, junto a...)
- Descripciones físicas. Adjetivos calificativos.
- Vocabulario relacionado con las emociones, los sentimientos y los estados de ánimo.
- Valores educativos como la amistad, la solidaridad, el esfuerzo colectivo, la autoestima.
- Identificación de las emociones básicas: alegría, tristeza, rabia, miedo, calma,... para conseguir un autocontrol emocional.
- Profundizar en herramientas que permitan un mejor autoconocimiento, una mayor autoestima y un aumento de habilidades sociales.





#### PLOT SYNOPSIS

A soft voiced Narrator welcomes us to the Eggmont World, a place full of magic, colour and stories. The first Eggmonts we meet are Tickle and Grumpy, with whom we learn the parts of the body. Not only do their names differentiate them, but also their colours and their characters are different. Tickle -the orange Egamont- always wants to tickle someone and make them laugh; on the other hand Grumpy -the red Eggmont- is always angry and upset. After listening to their respective songs, we see that their relationship is very peculiar. Tickle is determined to tickle Grumpy so that it smiles and is happy, but Grumpy, after being touched, strongly opposes it. Tickle will have to get the help of several volunteers to tickle Grumpy and make it a little happier. It is a story in which friendship prevails and the obviousness that everything we do is better with a smile. Grumpy finally accepts that laughing is good and healthy. In addition to this, both of the Eggmonts, with the help of a volunteer, write the word H-A-P-P-Y in large letters.

In the second story, we meet two more Eggmonts: Scary -the brown Eggmont- and Hug -the green Eggmont-. Both have their own presentation songs also. Scary always looks to scare anyone around it, that is its greatest pleasure; from the moment it wakes up and leaves its house, "The Terror House", in the morning to the time it goes home at night - it goes looking for someone to scare. In this case it finds Hug, a calm and peaceful Eggmont, who only wants to give hugs. Hug will be Scary's next victim, which Hug doesn't like at all. Hug will try to hug Scary, but Scary runs away, Scary doesnt want a hug. So Hug, with the help of some volunteers, goes to Scary's house to give it a good scare and a taste of its own medicine - using a map - and

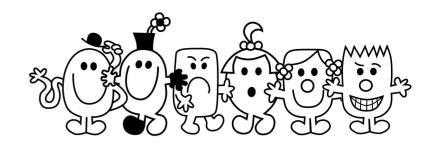
thus get Scary to let itself be hugged. Hug achieves this, as well as overcoming it's own fear.

In the third and last of the stories we meet Curious -the blue Eggmont- and Wrong -the pink Eggmont-. These two Eggmonts are also very different from each other. Curious always asks questions about everything around it: Why-How-When-Where -What... And it asks so many questions, that it ends up overwhelming everyone around it. Wrong, however, does not ask anything, but is constantly wrong, both in its wardrobe choices and in its actions. The encounter between the two is very funny, since they seem to be total opposites. The two have their respective song also, which allows us to understand more about them, and they dance quite happily. The fact that Wrong is always wrong makes Curious ask more and more questions. At one point. Curious writes a series of questions down, but is missing certain words; so Wrong, trys to help, but puts them all in the wrong order, which is why it gets help from a volunteer who puts everything in the correct order.

These three stories allow us to undestand more about these funny little creatures - called Eggmonts - as well as understanding more about our feelings and everything that makes up our emotional education.







#### SINOPSIS

Con una suave voz en off llegamos al mundo de los Eggmonts, un sitio lleno de magia, color y divertidas historias. Los primeros Eggmonts que conocemos son Tickle y Grumpy, con los que aprendemos, en primer lugar, las partes del cuerpo. A ambos no sólo les diferencia el nombre, sino también el color y su carácter. Tickle -Eggmont de color naranja- está siempre deseando hacer cosquillas; en cambio Grumpy - Eggmont de color rojo- está siempre enfadado. Después de escuchar las respectivas canciones que nos presentan a ambos, vemos que su relación es un tanto peculiar. Tickle está empeñado en hacerle cosquillas a Grumpy para que sonría y sea feliz, pero éste, poco dado a que lo toquen, se opone firmemente a ello. Tickle contará con la ayuda de varios voluntarios para conseguir hacerle cosquillas a Grumpy y así hacer que éste sea un poco más feliz. Una historia en la que prima el compañerismo y la obviedad de que todo lo que hagamos con una sonrisa sale mejor. Grumpy aceptará finalmente que reír es bueno y saludable. Además ambos contarán con la ayuda de un voluntario que les ayudará a escribir en letras grandes la palabra F-E-L-I-Z.

En la segunda de las historias conocemos a dos Eggmonts más: Scary -Eggmont de color marrón- y Hug -Eggmont de color verde-. Ambos cuentan con su canción de presentación. Scary siempre está dispuesto a dar sustos, ése su mayor deseo; desde que despierta y sale de su casa por la mañana -Terror House-, va buscando a quién asustar. En este caso encuentra a Hug, un Eggmont plácido y tranquilo, que sólo quiere dar abrazos. Hug será la víctima de los sustos de Scary, lo cual no le gusta demasiado. Hug intentará abrazar a Scary, pero lejos de lo que aquél desea, Scary no está dispuesto a ceder. Así que Hug, con la ayuda de voluntarios, irá hasta la temida casa de

Scary para darle un buen susto -haciendo uso del correspondiente mapa- y así conseguir que se deje abrazar. Hug conseguirá su objetivo, así como vencer su temor.

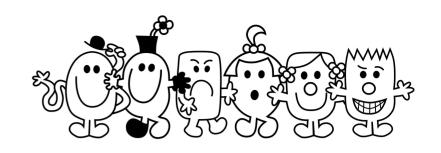
En la tercera y última de las historias conocemos a Curious -Eggmont de color azul- y a Wrong-Eggmont de color rosa-. Estos dos Eggmonts también son muy diferentes entre sí. Curious se pregunta siempre a sí misma todo lo que le rodea: Por qué- Cómo- Cuándo - Dónde - Cómo... son sus palabras repetidas. Y es tanta la cantidad de preguntas que llega a hacer, que acaba por agobiar a todos. Wrong, sin embargo, no pregunta nada, pero se equivoca constantemente, tanto en su vestuario, como en sus acciones. El encuentro entre ambos resulta muy divertido, puesto que parecen opuestos. Los dos tienen su respectiva canción, que nos permite saber más de ellos, y bailar animadamente. El hecho de que Wrong se equivoque siempre, hace que Curious haga más y más preguntas. Llegados a un punto, Curious escribe una serie de preguntas, pero le faltan palabras; así que Wrong, intentando ayudar, las coloca todas mal, motivo por el cual se cuenta con la ayuda de un voluntario que lo pone todo en orden.

Tres historias que nos permiten conocer más sobre estas divertidas criaturas -llamadas Eggmonts- así como el mundo de los sentimientos y todo aquello que conforma nuestra educación emocional.

### POST-PLAY ACTIVITY 2. COLOURS AND NUMBERS. TEACHERS



In this activity students will learn (or revise) the colours and the numbers from 1-6. There are six boxes and in each box there are some Eggmonts and a colour. Students have to colour the Eggmonts and write the number under the box.

En esta actividad, los alumnos aprenderán (o repasarán) los colores y los números del 1 al 6. Se dispondrán seis recuadros; en cada uno de ellos habrá algunos Eggmonts y un color. Now students have to complete the sentences for each box, using either a number or a colour, or both. Explain that "there is" is only used for single objects (e.g. "There is one Eggmont") and 'there are' is used for plural nouns (e.g. "There are four Eggmonts").

Los alumnos deben completar las frases correspondientes a cada recuadro, utilizando un número, un color o ambas cosas. El profesor explicará que "there is" solo se utiliza para un objeto en singular (e.g. "There is one Eggmont") y que cuando tengamos más de un objeto (plural), utilizaremos "there are" (e.g. "There are four Eggmonts").

### Answer key:

- 1. There is one pink Wrong.
- 2. There are two blue Curious.
- 3. There are three brown Scary.
- 4. There are four green Hug.
- 5. There are five red Grumpy.
- 6. There are six orange Tickle.

### Extension activity:

The teacher can now ask the students questions like:

"How many green Hug Eggmonts are there?"

"(There are) four (green Hug Eggmonts)".

## POST-PLAY ACTIVITY 3. WHO IS WHO? TRACK 17. TEACHERS



In this activity there are three sentences for each of the characters in the play. Students should listen to the sentences on the audio (TRACK 17) and once they recognize which is which, they should match them up with the corresponding characters: TICKLE - WRONG - CURIOUS - GRUMPY - SCARY - HUG.

Now they can listen to the audio (TRACK 16) again and repeat each sentence. As a final activity, the teacher should divide the class into groups of six (one student per character) and the students can perform a "mini-play".

Grumpy: I don't like that the sky is blue, or that the grass is green,

I don't like anything. And I am very angry.

Scary: 00000HHHHHH! I scared you. 0000HHHHH! Hahaha.

What a scare.

Scary: I'm going to scare all the Eggmonts. Heh, heh, heh.

when everything is dark.

Hug: I want to give you a big hug! Do you want one?

Hug: If I hug you, I'm sure you will feel better.

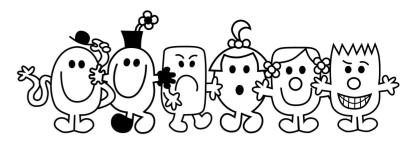

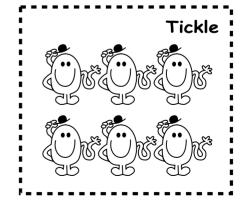


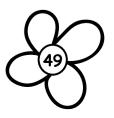






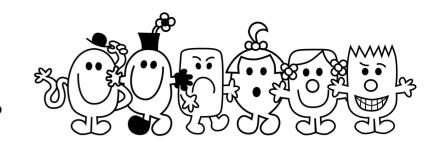








### POST-PLAY ACTIVITY 3. WHO IS WHO? TRACK 17. STUDENTS

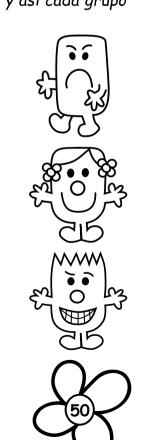

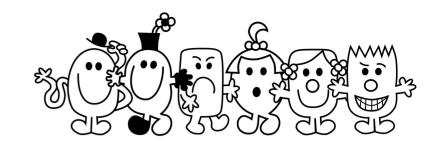








## EXTRA-ACTIVITY 1 FLASHCARDS



#### Part One:

The teacher shows all the flashcards to the students and they repeat the words aloud.

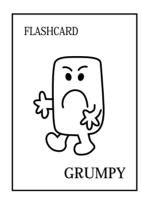

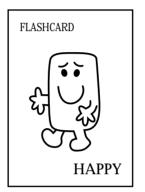

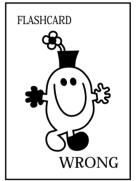
Every time a student chooses a card and sees the picture, he should say the opposite concept, since every flashcard has its corresponding opposite concept.

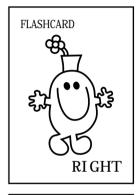

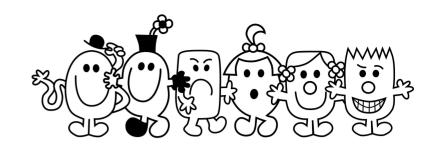
## EXTRA-ACTIVITY 2 BUILD YOUR OWN EGGMONT

Making puppets and playing with them benefits the development of children. It increases their attention span and increases activity. For that reason, we propose that in the classroom you can give life to your own puppets-Eggmonts. Do you want to give it a go? Construir marionetas y jugar con ellas beneficia el desarrollo de los niños, aumenta su capacidad de atención e incrementa su actividad. Por ello a continuación te proponemos que en el aula podáis dar vida a vuestros propias marionetas-Eggmonts. ¿Os atrevéis a ello?



### Materials you will need:

- Felt, many bright colours.
- A pencil.
- Scissors, needles and thread. Or glue. Or a stapler.
- Colourful pom-poms.



### Steps to follow:

1. Take several colourful pieces of felt to make your Eggmonts. To cut out the shape of the Eggmont you can make use of the template that we have provided.

2. Cut and join the two parts of the puppet with thick stitches, or

glue, or even simply staple them.

3. Add the parts of the face (eyes, mouth, nose), using your imagination.

- 4. You can complete the creation with pom-poms for the nose and legs or with other pieces of felt cut in different ways with which to decorate the Eggmont.
- 5. Once finished, determine its character and give it a name.

### Materiales que necesitas:

- Fieltro de colores llamativos.
- Un lápiz.
- Tijeras, agujas e hilo. O bien pegamento. O grapadora.
- Pompones de colores.

### Pasos a seguir:

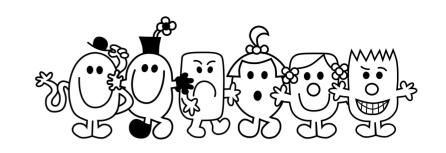
- 1. Coge varias piezas de fieltro de llamativos colores para hacer tus Eggmonts. Para recortar la forma del Eggmont haz uso de la plantilla que te proporcionamos.
- 2. Recorta y une las dos partes de la marioneta con unas puntadas gruesas, o con pegamento, o incluso simplemente grapándolas.
- 3. Añade las partes de la cara (ojos, boca, nariz), haciendo uso de tu imaginación.
- 4. Puedes completar la creación con pompones para la nariz y las patas o con otros trozos de fieltro cortados de diferentes formas con los que adornar al Eggmont.
- 5. Una vez realizado determina su carácter y ponle nombre.

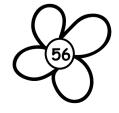

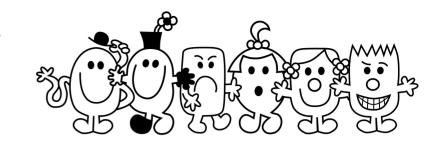
